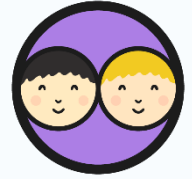

# Who Does It Belong To?

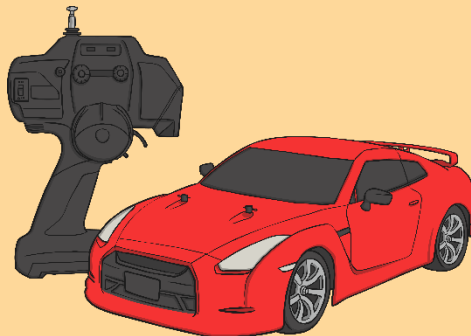


## Possession

When we own or have something it is called possession.



The blue bike belongs to Jacob.



The red car belongs to Jodie.



The football belongs to Samera.

# Apostrophes to Show Possession



When we say something belongs to someone, we add an 's' to the end of the word. However we also do this when the word becomes plural.

So we add an apostrophe before the 's' to show our reader we mean 'belongs to'.

one cat



The cat's bed



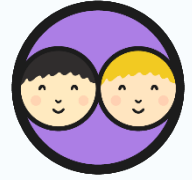
two cats
