Holidays/Leave During Term Time

We would like to remind parents and carers that schools are not allowed to authorise requests for children to be taken out of school in term time unless there are 'exceptional circumstances'. Exceptional circumstances do not include holidays.



Any leave of absence requests should be received at least 10 school days in advance to enable us to have time to consider the request (the form can be collected from the School Office or downloaded from the school website). Parents need to be aware that authorisation for these events is at the discretion of the Headteacher. Mrs Roberts will consider each request individually and will also take into account the child's attendance and punctuality record for previous years and up to the date the request is made.

The school is unable to consider or grant any authorised leave of absence for holidays or days out. If you take a holiday of 5 or more consecutive days then the matter will be referred to the Local Authority who will consider the issue of a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN). FPN's are issued to each parent and are for each child.

Year 6 SATs

Please note that the SATs tests will be in the week commencing Monday 13th May. The Year 6 children will be working very hard this term to revise and prepare for the tests and we thank you for your continued support.

Jewellery

Can we please remind you that children should not be wearing any jewellery other than a watch or stud earrings (earrings should be removed or covered by micro-pore tape during PE lessons). For safety reasons, hoop or dangly earrings, bracelets and necklaces are not allowed.
